The insight festival is delighted to announce it has decided to annul the administration charge for entries to the 2009 competition.

The premier award of £1000 plus an international screening in Brazil is still offered to the film judged as the best entry by our panel of expert judges.

The decision to drop an administration charge follows a number of exciting developments concerning Festival partnerships and a generous grant received to support its progress.

Those who have already entered and submitted a the ten pound administration charge will receive a refund.

Partnership has recently been announced with **Film International** the bi-monthly magazine covering all aspects of film culture and bringing together established film scholars with renowned journalists to provide an informed and animated commentary on the spectacle of world cinema.

The Festival shall shortly be making an exciting announcement concerning a further partnership with a UK based TV channel.

Festival director, John Forrest commented "We're delighted with our latest partnerships, and to now be in a position drop our administration charge for those entering the competition. We want to ensure that everyone who has made a film which explores faith from any perspective is encouraged to enter."

INSIGHT invites entries invited from young film makers whose work can explore the theme of 'faith'. The films may represent any faith position, and may made by those of any faith and none.
