

# INSIGHT FILM FESTIVAL YOUNG FILMMAKERS COMPETITION

#### THE COMPETITION

Young people aged 14-19 in schools and colleges across Greater Manchester are invited to make short films on **one** of the following themes:

- · I Don't Believe It!
- Leap of Faith
- · OMG!

You can interpret them in any way you like!

Films should be a **maximum of 2 minutes duration** and can be produced in **any format with any equipment** (cartoon, live action, stop-motion, music video, Vine, drama, documentary, comedy, silent movie, mobile phones etc.)

Films will be judged by professional filmmakers and members of the international Insight Film Festival board and team.

Winning films will be shown at **Z-arts in Hulme** during the **Insight Education Event** on **Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2014**.

### WHO CAN ENTER?

The Insight Young Filmmakers Competition is open to all **14-19 year olds** in schools and colleges across Greater Manchester.

- Students can work on their own or in a group.
- Films can be made in class, extra-curricular clubs, or at home.
- Films must be submitted to Insight by the schools/colleges, not individual students
- Schools/colleges can submit as many films by as many different students as they like.

#### **AWARDS**

- One winning school/college entrant will win the opportunity for a short series of mentored sessions facilitated by filmmakers in connection with the University of Manchester Screen Studies department. Filmmakers will work with school staff as mentors for a group of students in school/college between March and July 2014 to produce a film. This will form a submission as a UK entry to Plural+ Youth Video Festival 2014 (an initiative of the United Nations Association Of World Civilizations).
- Selected competition films will be shown on the big screen at Z-arts in Hulme during the Insight Education Event (Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2014).
- Prize winning competition entries will be awarded at a ceremony during the Insight Education Event (Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2014).
- All entrants will receive a certificate.

#### **HOW TO ENTER**

Once you've made your film, simply burn it onto a DVD, clearly labelled with:

- the title of your film
- your school/college
- student name(s)
- a contact telephone number and email address
